Dear Mr. Kanassatega:

Thank you for calling me on Tuesday of this week to discuss which MTE employees the government may interview in the course of this investigation outside the presence of an MTE representative. To further that discussion, we agreed that I would send you a list of the current MTE employees whom the government wishes to interview at this point, and that you would advise as to which of those employees fall outside the scope of MTE's legal representation.

Please contact me at your earliest convenience, but in any event by Friday, March 7, 2003, to advise as to the position of these employees and whether, in view of their position and duties, they fall outside the scope of MTE's legal representation (or whether, in any event, MTE consents to the interview of any of these employees outside the presence of MTE's counsel).

As we have discussed, upon being advised that the government may directly interview any or all of these employees, the government intends to contact such employees directly. However, the government will prepare reports of interview with regard to each employee interviewed. Moreover, if MTE takes the steps to cooperate outlined in my letter of February 7, 2003, the government would provide copies of the reports of interview to MTE at an appropriate time before a charging decision is made with regard to MTE.


