ORDER

This matter comes before the court on the United States' Expedited Motion to Amend the Scheduling Order. The motion seeks a thirty-day extension of the deadline for completion of fact and expert discovery, and to modify the dates for filing dispositive motions and briefs, pursuant to Rules 7 and 16(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and Civil Local Rules 7.4., 16.1(b) and 26.2. Having considered the submissions of the parties, the court finds that good cause has been shown. Therefore, upon the agreement of the parties, the Scheduling Order is hereby amended as follows:

1. June 15, 2008: Completion of fact and expert discovery.
2. July 1, 2008: Deadline for filing and service of dispositive motions.

All other terms of the Scheduling Order shall remain unchanged. The United States has indicated that it anticipates a thirty-day extension of the trial date, from September 8, 2008 to October 6, 2008, will be required in this case. Defendants, however, oppose any modification of

the trial schedule, and the court declines to reset the trial date at this time. If necessary, the United States may file a motion to postpone the trial date as it approaches.
